## **Medical Bills Ranges**

- The #1 error most people make when searching is adding a tight medical bills range.
- As an example, an Attorney ran a non-surgical back herniation search in a particular state with a \$45,000 to \$50,000 medical bills range and found 24 cases. We searched zero to \$50,000 and found 456 cases; 9 of the top 10 cases had less than \$45,000 in medical bills. One resolved for \$575K with meds of \$28,005.
- So, when you put tight meds ranges on searches, what are you typically excluding? Cases with a <u>similar fact pattern with lower medical bills that have stronger resolution amounts.</u> When we re-run searches removing the lower medical bills number, typically at least half of the top 10 cases will have lower medical bills than what was initially specified. We've seen it as high as 10 out of 10 when the range is very tight.
- You'll also miss <u>Verdicts</u>, which tend to have lower medical bills and higher awards.
